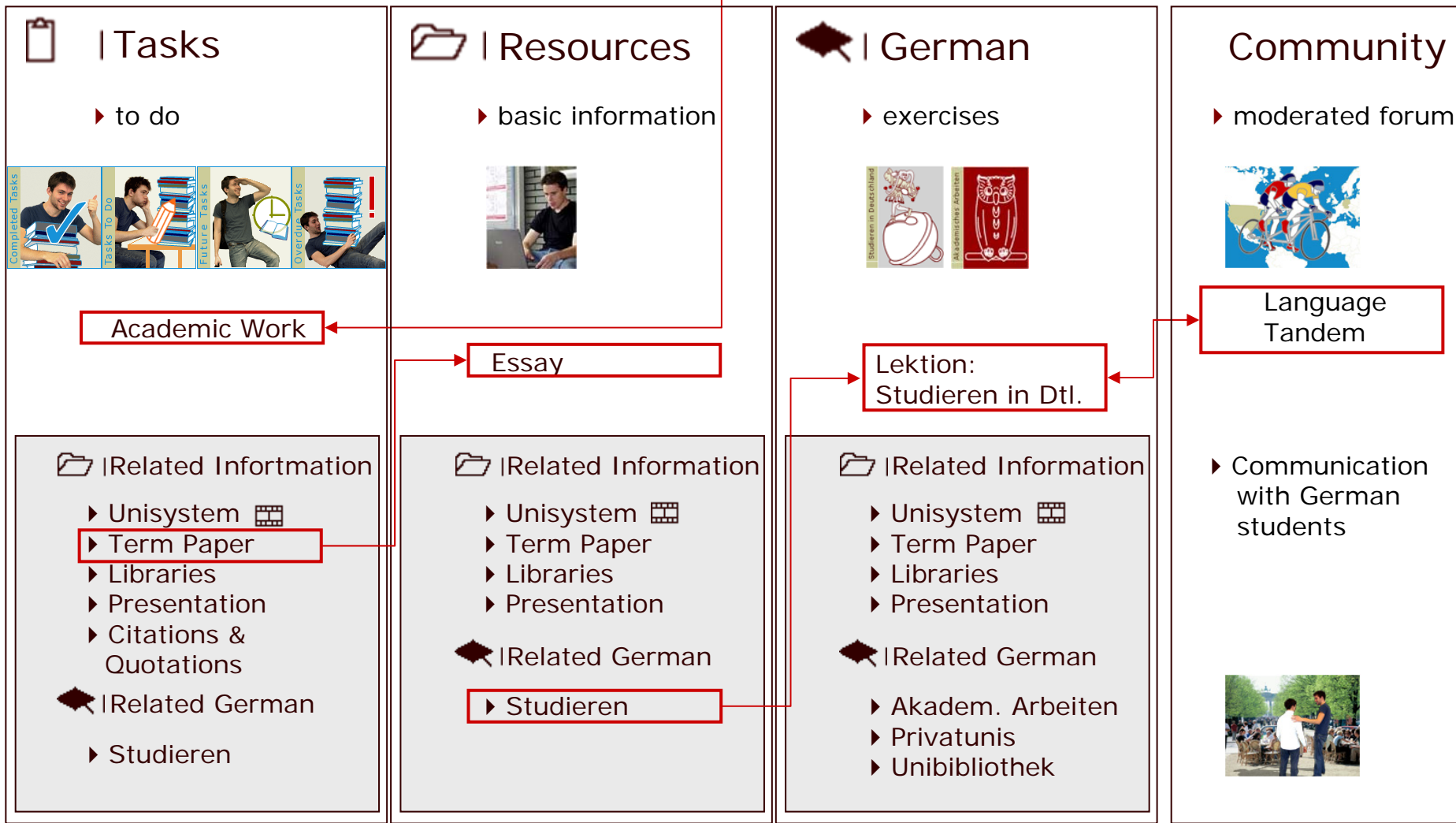
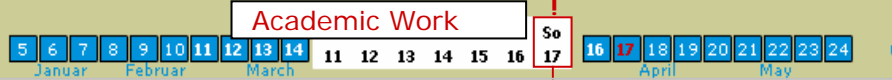

Distributed Campus coaching environment structure

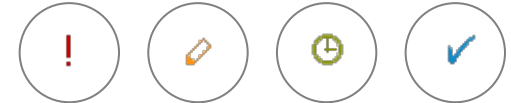

Use

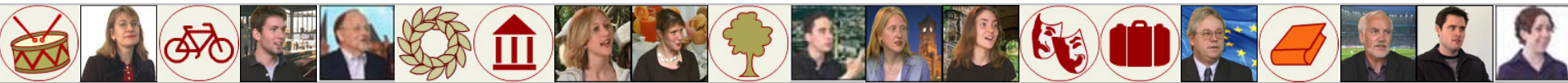

Updating

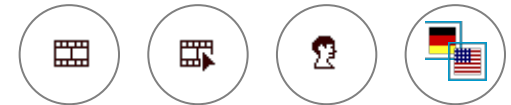
- Creation and updating by partner organizations (customization)

- ▶ modular, non-progressive course, exercises on intermediate level



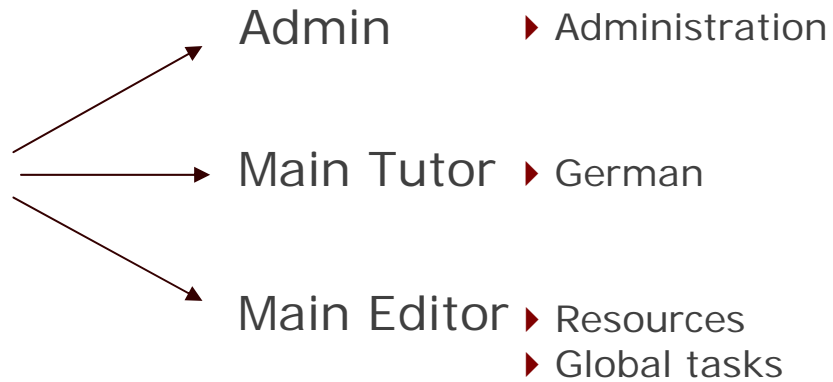
Community with forums and moderation

- Establishing contact to residential and academic staff on site in Berlin

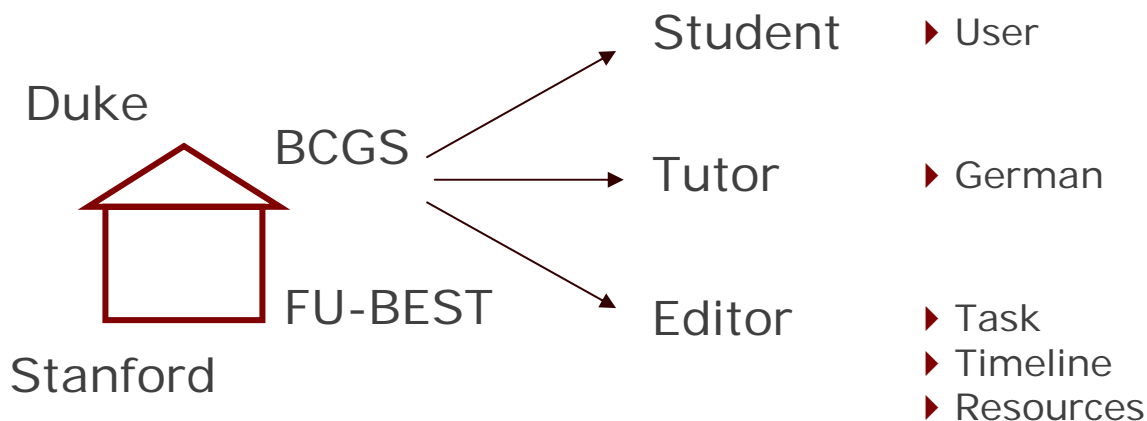
