

Postgraduate Office – Joint Doctorates

Very recent regulation: November 2010

A joint Doctorate (other names: Joint PhD; co-tutelle doctorate) is a doctoral degree awarded jointly by two (or more) different institutions. The doctoral student must undertake research in the partner institutions during a minimun period in each of them.

Each student requires the signature of a Partnership agreement

UNIVERSIDAD DE MURCIA

BUREAUCRACY



The doctoral candidate:

■ must have a supervisor in each institution.

must meet the entry requirements at each institution

must formally enroll at each institution, but might be exempted form paying the tuition fee at the University where the thesis will not be defended

must have an approved PhD research proposal at the University of Murcia

must carry out research at each institution for at least 9 months

must defend the PhD degree in one of the partner institutions

UNIVERSIDAD DE MURCIA

A very case-by- case proceeding

- Students from the EU
- Students from other countries of the EHEA
- Students from countries outside the EHEA they need to apply for the equivalence of their degrees
