Support for organizers

- Decentralized editing of online materials increases flexibility (time / place)
- All users access one central platform
- Decrease in students' questions via mail or phone

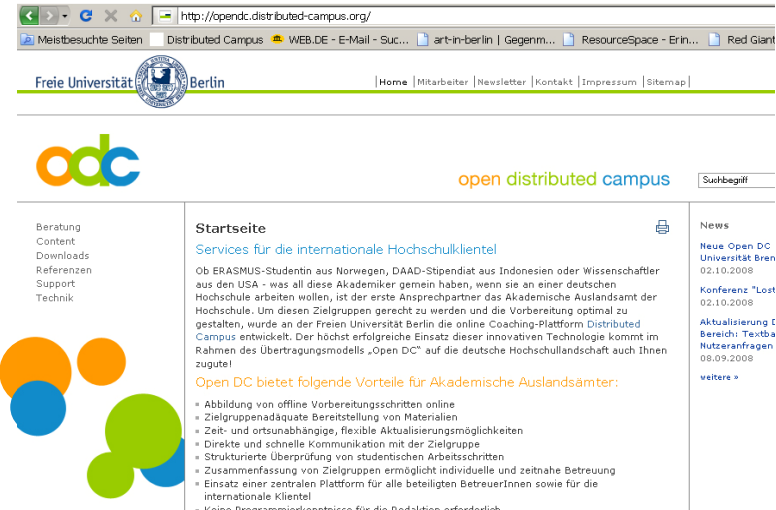
