Three main parts:

- 1. Information Centre and trainings and workshops: information and guidance concerning internships and job entrance; lectures and workshop program; online job offer exchange
- 2. General Professional Skills Courses (ABV): Personal and socialcommunicative skills; obligatory Internship Modules
- 3. Internships abroad (International Career Service): information and guidance; scholarship programs (e.g. ERASMUS, PROMOS, DAAD); international business corporation

The Career Service offers a range of modules within the **General Professional Skills Courses (ABV)** obligatory for bachelor students (ABV):

Personal and social-communicative skills :

- presentation and moderation training (5 credit points)
- interviewing and negotiation training (5 credit points)
- optimization of working process workshop(5 credit points)

Internship modules

- internship module (5, 10 or 15 credit points)
- internship abroad module (20, 25 or 30 credit points)

(the amount of credits depends on the duration of the internship)

- support of planning and preparation for the internship abroad

There is a **choice** between:

- the **internship module**, in which you purchase either 5, 10 or 15 (120, 240, or 380h) credit points. Here, the internship can both be completed at home as abroad.

or

- the internship abroad module (20, 25 oder 30 credit points), in which the students go abroad for a longer internship (520, 670 or 820h) - up to half a year
- all **internships modules** consist of an **external internship** and an **accompanying symposium**.
- both the number of smaller internships as well as several smaller internships abroad can each be combined into a larger home or abroad internship.





Within the ERASMUS-internship program Freie Universität offers scholarships for **self-organized internships for at least three months** in EU countries as well as Liechtenstein, Iceland, Norway and Turkey.

At one glance:

- advice on the preparation and implementation of internships
- monthly stipend (ca. 350 €)
- assistance in case of problems abroad
