#### **LOCATION AND CONTEXT**

#### •Murcia Region:

- •A one-province Autonomous Community in Southeastern Spain
- Population of 1,4 million people
- •Mediterranean climate: mostly sunny, soft winters and warm summers
- •Economy based on agriculture (Europe's orchard), industry, tourism (250 kms coastline) and services



#### •Murcia City:

- Founded by the Moors in 825 AD
- Capital and main city: 450,000 inhabitants
- Services city and university town

#### •Universities:

- Universidad de Murcia
- Universidad Politécnica de Cartagena
- Universidad Católica San Antonio (private)

#### **HISTORY**

- •Its origins date back to medieval times, being Murcia a cultural melting pot
- •Founded as Universitas Studiorum Murciana by the King Alfonso X of Castile, known as Alfonso X The Wise, in 1272 AD (see university's seal)



- Currently on its third foundation in 1915
- •10th oldest university in Spain
- •Great growth on student population, academic offer, research activities and university facilities in the last two decades.

Located 70 kms away from Murcia city Recently built. Nursing and nutrition studies.


## THE FINE ARTS FACULTY: FACULTAD DE BELLAS ARTES

# THE UNIVERSITY OF MURCIA – JOINT DOCTORATES

### **Postgraduate Office – Joint Doctorates**

Very recent regulation: November 2010

A joint Doctorate (other names: Joint PhD; co-tutelle doctorate) is a doctoral degree awarded jointly by two (or more) different institutions. The doctoral student must undertake research in the partner institutions during a minimun period in each of them.

Each student requires the signature of a Partnership agreement



## **BUREAUCRACY**



#### The doctoral candidate:

- must have a supervisor in each institution.
- must meet the entry requirements at each institution
- ■must formally enroll at each institution, but might be exempted form paying the tuition fee at the University where the thesis will not be defended
- ■must have an approved PhD research proposal at the University of Murcia
- must carry out research at each institution for at least 9 months
- ■must defend the PhD degree in one of the partner institutions



A very case-by- case proceeding

- Students from the EU
- Students from other countries of the EHEA
- Students from countries outside the EHEA they need to apply for the equivalence of their degrees



The Mediterranean Office for Youth (MOY) brings together 16 Mediterranean countries to promote the mobility of students and joint delivery of masters and doctoral degrees.
