  - + Brand new business centre



- ★ At least 18 years of age
- Expected to be HE ready/enrolled
- + At least 3.0 GPA
- → English language of IELTS 6.5

#### **Immigration**

- Visa national countries Student Visitor
- Non-visa national apply for Student Visitor visa

#### Medical

- + Full medical and travel insurance mandatory
- Medical centre and dental practice on campus
- → Pharmacy on campus


#### Our basic fee is inclusive of
